Marrickville Spirit Winter Cup

Tournament Overview

- The tournament is run by MSBA and hosted at Sydney Boys High School
- All teams will play **4 games**, regardless of their results, to ensure a full and enjoyable tournament experience.
- There will be no shot clock
- Games will consist of **two 14-minute halves** with a **running clock**.
- Each team is allowed **one timeout per game** (clock continues to run during timeouts, except when game is within 6 points with under 1 minute remaining).
- The tournament fosters values of **teamwork**, **respect**, **fairness**, and **sportsmanship** for all participants, coaches, parents, and spectators.

General Participation Guidelines

Eligibility and Registration

- All players must have a **current BNSW registration**. Secondary registration is required for players with a primary membership at another association.
- Players are **not permitted to participate** without a valid BNSW registration.
- Teams will be assigned to age groups based on **Basketball NSW** and **Basketball Australia** age eligibility guidelines.
- Requests for special consideration must be submitted in writing to: development@spiritbasketball.com.au.

Team Formation

- Players will pay an individual registration fee of \$70.
- There are a minimum of 6 players per team
- Teams need to wear matching singlets with numbers

Game Rules

Timing & Format

- Each game consists of **two 14-minute halves**.
- The **clock runs continuously**, including during timeouts, except when the game is within 6 points with 1 minute remaining.
- There is a **1-minute halftime break**.
- Each team is permitted 1 timeout per game, with the clock continuing to run.
- Draws are allowed during pool games, but during knockout rounds overtime will take place on a first basket wins basis.

Fouls

• **Bonus free throws** are awarded on and after the 6th team foul (excluding offensive fouls).

Gameplay Rules by Age Group

- U14s: Size 6 basketball.
- U16s & U18s: Size 7 basketball (boys); size 6 for girls.
- **Zone defence** is not allowed in U14s. Only man-to-man defence is permitted.
- Trapping defences that revert to man-to-man are allowed.

Uniform & Equipment

- All players on a team must wear **matching uniforms** with **unique visible numbers**. You cannot share singlets with teammates.
- No jewellery may be worn during games.
- Nails must be short or taped to avoid injury.
- Players out of uniform may be deemed ineligible to play.

Conduct & Discipline

Codes of Behaviour

- All players, coaches, and spectators must follow Basketball NSW Codes of Conduct
- Zero tolerance applies to verbal abuse, intimidation, or unsportsmanlike behaviour.

Tournament Structure

- Each team will play 4 games during the tournament.
- At least two pool games
- Semi and grand final
- Consolation bracket for losers

Other Regulations

- Players may not play for more than one team in the same age group.
- Only active players, coaches, and officials are allowed on court during games
